WHAT ARE WE:

A water skills training program teaching canoeing, kayaking and sailing skills with the emphasis on having FUN!

WHO ARE WE:

Dedicated Scout Leaders, Paddle Canada Instructors, and Kayak Instructors with Whitewater Ontario Safety Training !

WHERE ARE WE:

Our Boathouse is located at **Rogers Cove** in Peterborough, Ontario, just south of the intersection of Mark & Maria Streets !

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE:

All Youth who will be at least 11 years or older by the end of the current year may register. Our program is open to the General Public, Scouting, and Guiding.

General Program Info:

Runs during the summer from June 20 to August 15. Participants attend Tuesday & Thursday evenings, for those weeks. Youth need to attend all evenings where possible. If more than 2 evenings are missed, it is possible they will not meet all requirements. Please let us know in advance of absences. Each Section also has the opportunity to participate in **Weekend Trips**.

Basic Canoeing Section:

(1st Year) Basic canoeing skills and have the opportunity to participate in weekend canoe camping trips. **Paddle Canada Canoeing Basic Skills** certification for successful completion!

Intermediate Canoe & Kayak Section:

(2nd Year) Canoe & Kayak on alternate nights. More advanced Canoeing skills leading to **Paddle Canada Introduction Lake Canoe** certification. Also, introduction to **Kayaking** skills!

Advanced Canoe & Kayak Section:

(3rd Year) Canoe & Kayak on alternate nights. Canoe Tripping skills leading to **Paddle Canada Introduction to Canoe Tripping** certification (planning & participating in a weekend trip required). Also, more advanced **Kayaking** skills!

Sailing Section:

(4th & 5th Years) Participants are introduced to sailing and have the opportunity to participate in sailing camps.

No previous experience required! Younger participants always start with Basic Level.

Our friendly and knowledgeable staff can place older Youth in the appropriate section depending on their skill level and interest.
